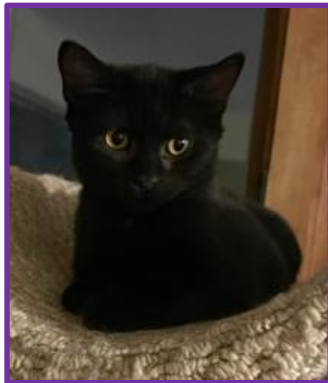


NAME: Tanner
