Scotia came to 4Paws from West Virginia with her friend Charmaine. They were surrendered because their owner could no longer care for them. Although they have lived together Scotia and Charmaine are not bonded and can be adopted separately.

Scotia is a petite young cat with bright eyes and long fur which gives her a “muppet” quality (Cutest Paws Award 2022!) Scotia is a quiet and polite girl, preferring to solicit attention of her human by running up and making eye contact. Her favorite

spot in foster was the top of a 36-inch scratching post in the middle of the room, where she would perch herself to observe all her surrounding areas. She is submissive and will let other cats squeeze into her food bowl so her new owners need to be vigilant if she is placed with another cat. She would do fine as an only cat, with other cats, or with canine companions. Scotia is still young so will need someone attentive to her exercise and energy needs. Although she doesn't become mischievous when bored, she still needs that outlet for her energy on occasion.

Scotia came to 4Paws with a persistent flea allergy which caused her fur to become patchy and her skin to get scabbed up around her neck so 4Paws recommends a monthly flea treatment to insure this doesn't happen again, especially if there are dogs that go in and out of the house.

Scotia has had her vaccinations, is microchipped, and has been spayed. She has tested negative for FeLV and FIV.

Scotia will pick at canned food but prefers to eat dry food. She is eating Fancy Feast class pate and grilled varieties and Purina One kibble.
