She had to have minor surgery to have that removed. Although her left eye does not look 100% normal, it is visual. Pansy can eat two cans in one meal and wolfs her food down, probably because she had two brothers in foster, so it was always a race even

though there was plenty of food.

Pansy likes to run around and play with other cats and toys. She loves chewing on cardboard and shreds boxes if she has access to them. If she sits still long enough for you to pick her up, she will purr and make little trilling noises. Pansy loves to interact with other kitties and would do well in an active home with children of all ages. She likes climbing up on your shoulders while you walk around and being up high. She is a higher energy cat so will need a similarly-suited feline playmate in her new home to keep her from getting bored. Additionally, Pansy would not be well-suited for a home with a cat that is older and can't keep up with her antics and play unless the humans in the home are prepared to help her burn off some energy with constructive play and exercise.
