

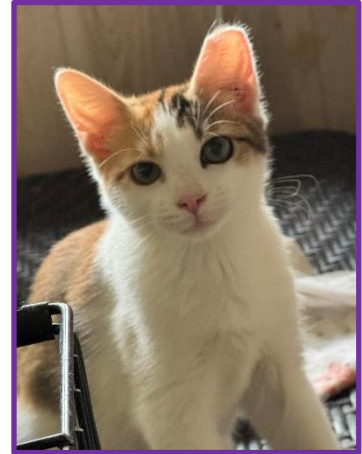
NAME: Callie

Background: Callie was acquired during a TNR (Trap-Neuter-Return) operation in southeastern North Carolina. When she was processed for her spay and initial vetting her left ear was tipped because her level of tameness had not been assessed. If she was feral, she would have to be returned where she was trapped. The left ear tip is used as a sign to future TNR personnel that she is already spayed, so if she is caught again, they don't have to process her for the spay clinic. Thankfully she was friendly to humans and so was turned over to Beaufort Community Cats for transport up to 4Paws for Meows Corner intake.

Medical or special care notes: Callie has had vaccinations for rabies and distemper, is microchipped, and has been spayed. She has tested negative for FeLV and FIV. She is eating Fancy Feast classic pate and Purina One kibble.
